## Septage Hauling Agreement

This agreement provides for adequate maintenance of a holding tank; we hereby agree to following terms:

The tank shall use an alarm to be set at 25% reserve capacity and shall be pumped when 75% capacity is reached; or once per year on or before October 31<sup>st</sup> of every year unless high groundwater conditions are problematic; OR when required by Hubbard County Environmental Services. It shall be the responsibility of the property owner to contact the licensed septage hauler when the alarm indicates 75% capacity has been reached. It shall be the responsibility of the licensed septage hauler to respond within 48 hours of such notification. Additionally, if nuisance conditions develop or any ground surfacing is observed, tank removal may be required.

It shall be the responsibility of the property owner to submit to Environmental Services by April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year a newly signed agreement identical to this agreement with a Hubbard County licensed septage hauler. In addition, the property owner is required to submit evidence of having the holding tank maintained and serviced. Failure to submit said agreement and pumping evidence may be grounds for the County to require removal of the holding tank.

Any other conditions attached to approval of the holding tank shall also be adhered to or tank removal may be required.
