- **Shoreland Management Ordinance violation – request authorization to forward to County Attorney**

I request authorization to forward one Shoreland Management Ordinance violation file to the County Attorney's office for further enforcement. The Commissioner in whose district the property is located was informed the matter would be placed on this agenda per standard procedure.

Other:

- **2020 Census Local Update of Census Addresses (LUCA) Project completed**

Our LUCA updates have been submitted to the U.S. Census Bureau. A total of 10,252 addresses were reviewed with an estimated 100 hours of staff time spent on the project over the course of 9-10 weeks. Address review was prioritized by areas with the largest discrepancies between the Bureau's records and the County's records as well as ensuring the Census had the most recent years of new residential addresses. Missing roads were also added as necessary. The below chart shows a breakdown of the number/percentage of address deletions/additions and addresses changed or not changed of the 10,252 reviewed:

Added	707	6.8%
Changed	1,768	17.2%

- **E911 change of address fee discussion**

The LUCA project identified some situations where properties were found to have incorrect E911 addresses. Sometimes this is due to voluntary actions taken by a landowner. Other times it is due to something that is beyond a landowner's control (e.g. a new home is constructed on an unnamed road that triggers the road to be named and existing homes on it to be readdressed per the new road name.) As what fees, if any, to charge when is a Board policy matter, I would like your input on if/when you would like to cover part of our costs by collecting the \$50 address fee and the \$175 road sign fee (when applicable) or if you would rather not charge fees for these items and instead absorb the costs in other ways.
